Romeo and Juliet will combine the best of both English literature and Ohio history for a truly unique show.

Set on the 18th century American frontier, tensions flare between the frontiersmen and the Native American tribes as each struggles to occupy their own territories.

Yet, when young Romeo sneaks onto Indian land, he finds a chance for love in the chief's daughter, Juliet. While the relationship flowers, the feuding peoples continue to shed blood. With their future in jeopardy, the two lovers are forced to take drastic actions in an attempt to escape their families' rage.

LOCATION / DIRECTIONS: *Romeo & Juliet* will be performed at the Sugarloaf Mountain Amphitheatre, home of the outdoor drama TECUMSEH!, located at 5968 Marietta Road, Chillicothe, Ohio, 45601. Watch for brown or green highway signs marked “OUTDOOR DRAMA” which will direct you to the amphitheatre.

TECUMSEH! Concessions: Snacks, including pizza, popcorn, ice-cream, candy, and soft drinks are available at the concession stand from 5:00 PM through intermission.

GIFT SHOP: The Mountain Gallery Gift Shop is located in the Arthur Rolette Memorial Pavilion and features many interesting and unique gifts and souvenirs, including hand crafted Indian jewelry, pottery, T-shirts, books, and postcards. The gift shop will open be open from 5:00 pm - 7:00 pm, during intermission and after the performance.

CAMERA POLICY: Cameras, video and sound recorders are **NOT** permitted in the amphitheatre during the performance.

RAIN POLICY: In the event of inclement weather or acts of God, a “rain hold” will be announced. The audience may retire to the rain shelter, pavilion or restaurant terrace while radar is checked. If a performance is officially cancelled, rain checks will be honored for any future available performance (*Romeo & Juliet* or TECUMSEH!) as payment toward tickets of equal or lesser value, or as partial payment toward tickets of greater value. **NO REFUNDS.** If patrons leave of their own volition and the show continues, no rain check will be given. The show will be performed during a light continuous rain.

Not recommended for children age 6 and under due to some violence (suicide & murder). Limited pyrotechnics, just a few gunshots and no cannon.
